

Directions to the White Plains office

When following directions from your GPS, be sure to follow them to West Harrison and not White Plains.

222 Westchester Ave. is located in the large building at the rear of the campus (behind the flagpole). Parking is accessed from the ramp to the left of the building.

From the east: (Connecticut and Interstate 95)

• Take I 287 west to exit 9N-S. This exits onto Westchester Ave. westbound. Follow for approximately 2-1/4 miles. Turn right into 220-230 HTA Westchester Medical Campus entrance.

From the west: (Gov. Mario Cuomo / Tappan Zee Bridge and Tarrytown)

• I 287 east to exit 8E. Stay in middle lane thru the first light on Westchester Ave. Proceed to the second traffic light and make left turn over the WML Butcher Bridge. Turn left again onto Westchester Ave. westbound. Turn right into 220-230 HTA Westchester Medical Campus entrance.

From the south:

- Saw Mill River Parkway or Sprain Brook Parkway to I 287 east to exit 8E. Stay in the middle lane thru first light on Westchester Ave. Proceed to the second traffic light and make left turn over the WML Butcher Bridge. Turn right into 220-230 HTA Westchester Medical Campus entrance.
- Hutchinson River Parkway north to exit 15B. This exits onto Westchester Ave. Stay on Westchester Ave. for 1-1/4 miles. Turn right into 220-230 HTA Westchester Medical Campus entrance.

From the north:

- I 684 south to Westchester Ave. White Plains exit. Stay to the far right and follow signs to Westchester Ave. Follow Westchester Ave. for approximately 1/2 mile. Turn right into 220-230 HTA Westchester Medical Campus entrance.
- Merritt Parkway to Hutchinson River Parkway south to exit 15B. This exits onto Westchester Ave. Stay on Westchester Ave. for 1-1/4 miles turn right into 220-230 HTA Westchester Medical Campus entrance

From White Plains center:

Follow Bryant Ave. north and cross over I 287. Make a left onto Westchester Ave. heading westbound.
Stay on Westchester ave. for approximately 1 mile. Turn right into 220-230 HTA Westchester Medical Campus entrance.
